This ensures the essentials of life (water for living) is available to all, yet waste of precious and scarce water is avoided.





Abberfield can supply councils with stored value cards that they can issue to needy residents. These cards can then only be used in the Pay Stations.

## Debit Cards for Free Water

Similar to stored value cards but easier to implement as no changes are needed to the standard Water Dispensing Stations.

# Free or Discounted Drought Relief Account Cards

Account cards can be issued to operate in a number of ways:

- 1. Provide free water.
- 2. Provide discounted water.

Note the water price can be set by Council on an internet portal at any time, including cancelling a cards use.

3. Deferred payment to Council for water taken. This allows users to pay when the drought has broken.

#### **Token for Water**

The Abberfield Water Filling Stations can have a token validator added (token face plate next to the credit card reader).

Then tokens can be issued by Council for free water.

Abberfield invite discussions on how these and other options can assist Councils meet their logistical and humanitarian objectives.

Abberfield Technology operate on similar principles of fairness yet commercial viability. With moral compass Abberfield choose to support, not exploit the drought ravished rural community. Senior Executives travel widely to see Councils and know the realties of these hard times, reinforced by also owning a part-time operated country vineyard.

Within reasonable limits Abberfield Technology offer Councils and Water Authorities to rent Water Dispensing Systems, or purchase on a deferred payment plan.

Part of the Abberfield fairness for purpose objective has been to design an optional mounting platform, that converts a Water Dispensing Station into a transportable module. These systems can be installed in places of greatest need and moved around as required.

Abberfield believe Water Filling Stations should be permanent infrastructures experiences shows that they receive post-drought usage.

However, recognising the immediate need, Abberfield will assist in anyway possible, including a deferred payment plan for new equipment.
